

building at 60 Cranberry Highway in Orleans, Massachusetts.

exhibition It's All in the Details featuring Kitson, Robert Bolster, and woodcarver Eric Kaiser happens July 30 to August 12. Then, from August 13 through 26 will be Kindred Spirits, Artistic Souls with Whelan and Michael J. Mariano, who plan to collaborate on a few paintings, with a demonstration scheduled for the opening on August 13 from 5 to 7 p.m.
